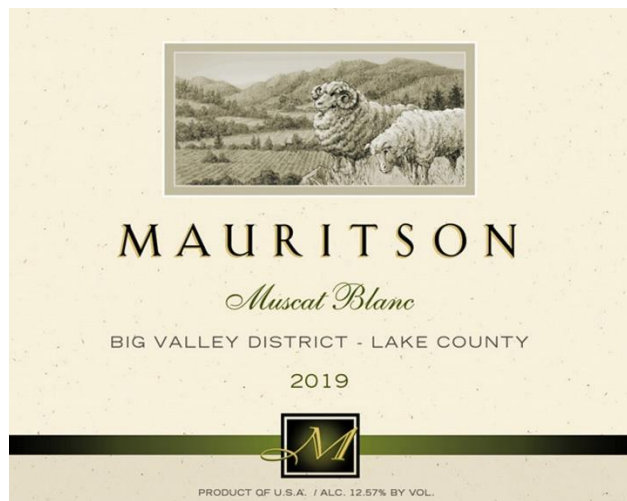

Winemakers' Perspective

We are incredibly excited to introduce the first vintage of a beautifully aromatic varietal: our dry Muscat Blanc. The grapes for this wine were selected from just a few rows of one of our family's organically farmed vineyards in Lake County. The Muscat Blanc juice is fermented entirely in stainless steel and has not gone through malolactic fermentation, preserving the detailed nuance of this grape.

This wine has intense aromas of perfumed lily of the valley blossom, key lime mousse and sweet wet stone. For Carrie Mauritson, the Muscat's exotic aromatics transport her back to her childhood in Durban, South Africa, where she first encountered the fragrance of lychees. Bone dry and bright, the flavors are a continuation of the gorgeous aromas. Enjoy this wine over the next 12-18 months with lighter fare or while enjoying a picnic with family and friends!
