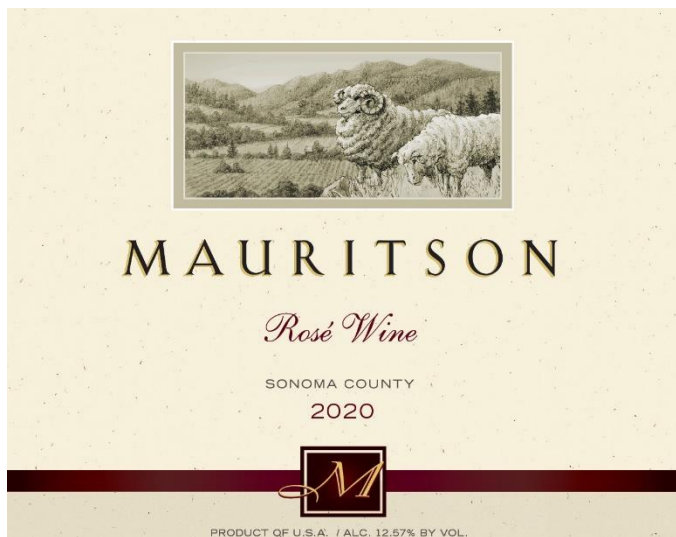

## Winemakers' Perspective

Our 2020 Rosé was made by whole-cluster pressing 100 percent Zinfandel. This practice produces lightly colored and delicate wines. The Rosé juice was also fermented entirely in stainless steel and has not gone through malolactic fermentation, preserving the bright, fresh, natural malic acid in the grapes.

This wine has an elegant rose-gold pink hue, with scents of dried rose-petal, crushed pomegranate seeds and traces of white melon skin. Bone dry, its berry fruits and crushed river rock core give way to a long and refreshing finish. Enjoy this wine over the next 12-18 months with lighter fare or while enjoying a picnic with family and friends!
