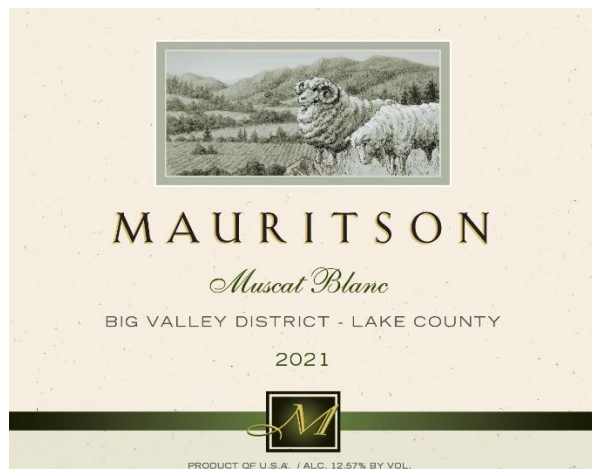

Winemakers' Perspective

This is the second iteration of our beautifully aromatic dry Muscat Blanc; one of the oldest grape varieties in the world. The grapes for this wine were selected from just a few rows of one of our family's organically farmed vineyards in Lake County. The Muscat Blanc juice is fermented entirely in stainless steel and has not gone through malolactic fermentation, preserving the detailed nuance of this grape.

This wine has intense aromas of perfumed bergamot oil, Mock Orange blossom, dried old fashion rose, and undertones of spicy fresh herb. For Carrie Mauritson, the Muscat's exotic aromatics transport her back to her childhood in Durban, South Africa, where she first encountered the intoxicating fragrance of lychees. Bone dry and bright, the flavors are a continuation of the gorgeous aromas. Enjoy this wine over the next 12-18 months with lighter fare or while enjoying a picnic with family and friends!
