

This is the fourth iteration of our beautifully aromatic dry Muscat Blanc, showcasing one of the oldest grape varietals in the world. We select the fruit for this wine from just a few rows in one of our family's organically farmed vineyards in Lake County, ferment the juice entirely in stainless steel and forgo malolactic fermentation, preserving the meticulous nuance of this grape.

On the nose, a perfume of candied orange rind, evening jasmine blossom, ripe Golden Nectar Asian plum flesh and dried Noisette rose greets you. For Carrie Mauritson, our Muscat's exotic aromatics transport her back to her childhood in Durban, South Africa, where she first encountered the intoxicating fragrance of lychee. Absolutely bone dry and energetic, the flavors of this 2023 release are a continuation of the spectacular aromas. Enjoy this wine over the next 12-18 months with lighter and spicy fare or while sharing a picnic with family and friends!
